"There is no such thing as an unforgivable sin. No! There is no sin or blasphemy that is not forgivable. If you blaspheme against the Holy Spirit and you ask for forgiveness genuinely in the name of Jesus and show remorse, and determine that you won't do such a thing again, I will forgive you.

The Holy Spirit does not enter into a person without bringing the gifts the person will utilize for the work of the Lord. The transforming power and ministration power and the ministration gifts, all enter at the same time.

It is a very big heresy to say that the Holy Spirit is not a living Person, that he is not God or to say that he is subordinate to God.

Whatever gift I give a person, he should ensure that he is using it effectively. He should not try to envy another person's gift or copy another person. He should face his own gift, and use it effectively. It is I that know how I judge rewards for people.

The Holy Spirit does not give just one fruit to people. All of the nine attributes listed [Galatians 5:2] are fruits. They are fruits. Each of them is a fruit. There are even more than those in fact, not just those nine."
